Jesus Lopez-Rodriguez is Associate Professor of Economics at A Coruña University (Universidade da Coruña), where he has taught since 1997. He is also a senior research fellow at the Jean Monnet Research Group on Competition and Regional Development (C+D) where he served as director from 2013-2015. During 2013 and 2014 he worked at the Institute for Prospective Technological Studies-Joint Research Centre (IPTS-JRC), of the European Commission as a senior economist. He has an extensive track record of research in geographical economics, regional growth and disparities, EU regional policy, EU political economy, industrial economics and more recently in public economics. Lopez-Rodriguez has presented his research in more than 100 international conferences, including the conferences of the European Economic Association (EEA), the European Association for Research in Industrial Economics (EARIE) and the Simposio de Analisis Economico (SAE) and has been invited to give economic seminars in different national and international institutions such as the Univ. of Cincinnati, Univ. of Illinois, Univ. of Arizona, Univ. of Texas, Georgia State Univ., Exeter Univ., Cardiff Business School., Sabanci Univ., Ecole d'Économie University d'Auvergne, DG Regio, Universidad Torcuato di Tella, Eafit, Universidad de los Andes, Banco de la República de Colombia. Lopez-Rodriguez has also been invited as keynote speaker at several international conferences, International Conference on Marketing, Economics and Business Management (2017), International Conference TIMTED (2013), ICABE (2012) and as a Guest lecturer at Al-Balqa Applied University (2017), Pompeu Fabra University (2016) UNAULA University (2016) Pablo de Olavide University among others.

Lopez-Rodriguez has been a visiting scholar at a number of universities including Harvard University (2007-08 and 2012), London School of Economics (2004, 2005, 2011), Institute of Capital, Creativity and Innovation at University of Texas (2003) and University of Exeter (1999,

2000, 2001). He has acted as consultant to several institutions including the DG Regio, European Commission, European Parliament, Galician Court of Competition, Basque Court of Competition, Galicia Innovation agency

His research work has been published in leading international journals such as *Regional Studies*, *Economics Letters*, *Applied Economics*, *Structural Change in Economics and Dynamics*, *European Journal of Law and Economics*, *Constitutional Political Economy*, *Prague Economic Papers*, *European Planning Studies* among others and recognized with the 2005 A Coruña University Ph.D. Dissertation Award (Premio Extraordinario de doctorado), the Best Paper Award in Economics at the 2004 Applied Business Research Conference, a third position at the 2015 Dr. Ernest Feder Annual Award given by Instituto de Investigaciones Económicas, UNAM and two positive research tranches for the periods 2001-2006 and 2007-2012 given by the Spanish National Agency for Research Evaluation (CNEAI). In January 2016 he got the accreditation for Full Professor (Catedrático de Universidad), the highest rank at the Spanish university system, given by the Spanish National Agency for quality and accreditation (ANECA).

Lopez-Rodriguez received his BA in Economics (1997) and PhD in economics (2002) from A Coruña University.
