

SASCHA KRAUS is a **Research Professor for Innovation & Entrepreneurship at ESCE International Business School, Paris, France**. Before, he was a Full Professor and Chairholder in Strategic Management and Entrepreneurship at the University of Liechtenstein, and, parallel to that, Visiting Professor at Copenhagen Business School, Denmark in 2015 and at the University of St. Gallen, Switzerland in the two years before.

He holds a doctorate in Social and Economic Sciences from Klagenfurt University, Austria, a Ph.D. degree in Industrial Engineering and Management from Helsinki University of Technology and a Habilitation (Venia Docendi) from Laapeenranta University of Technology, both in Finland. From 2008-2013, he was Full Professor and Chairholder in Entrepreneurship at Utrecht University, The Netherlands, which also awarded him with the highest Dutch qualification as a university professor, the “Senior Kwalificatie Onderwijs”. In 2008, he was also Participating Professor at the “European Entrepreneurship Colloquium on Participant-Centered Learning” (EECPCL) at Harvard University.

Professor Kraus is – according to the leading German financial magazine “Handelsblatt” – one of the “Top 20 Researchers in Business & Management” in all German-speaking countries. His main research areas are Strategy, Internationalization, Entrepreneurship and Innovation. He is the author of more than 100 academic articles, his research being published in outlets such as the Journal of Product Innovation Management, the Journal of World Business, the Journal of Business Research, Industrial Marketing Management, Entrepreneurship & Regional Development or Small Business Economics. He holds an *h*-Index of 39 and ca. 5,000 citations according to Google Scholar (as of June 2018).
