TIMTED International Conference welcomes electronic submissions of extended abstracts sent in Word format (until 15 April 2025).

Submission guidelines

Authors can submit a maximum of two **extended abstracts**. Please write your text in English (American or British, not a mixture of these) and prepare your manuscript considering the following guidelines.

Please make sure to mention your co-authors’ names. Co-authors’ names will be published in the programme and conference abstract book precisely as indicated in the submitted extended abstract(s).

Extended abstracts should be between 3000 and 6000 characters long (with spaces) and structured using the following subheadings:

- **Title:** maximum length *200 characters with spaces*; the title should be clear, concise, and indicative of the main focus of your study.
- **Names of authors:** Name and SURNAME (in capital letters), affiliation, city,

- **Introduction/Purpose/Objective** (*about 1000 characters with spaces*): Start with a brief introduction that provides context for your research. This section indicates the background, significance, and scope of the research undertaken, as well as the research objective or main research question and key contributions of the paper.
- **Brief Literature Review** (*about 1000 characters with spaces*): Indicate the current state of knowledge related to the research topic.
- **Design/Methodology/Approach** (*about 1000 characters with spaces*): Present the main methods or approaches you employed to conduct the research, and the data used, showing their relevance in achieving the abovementioned objectives. Include key details such as the study design, participants, materials, and procedures.
- **Results and Discussion/Findings** (*about 1000 characters with spaces*): Summarize the main findings of your research. Focus on the most important and relevant results. Use quantitative data if applicable.
- **Significance/Implications/Conclusions** (*about 1000 characters with spaces*): Briefly discuss the significance of your findings and their implications for the field of study. Why is your research important? Provide a concise reasoning that directly relates to your research objective or question. Summarize the main policy/managerial implications of your research for a wide range of stakeholders. End with a concluding sentence that summarizes the overall contribution of your research.
- **Limitations** (*if applicable, about 500 characters with spaces*): Acknowledge any limitations in your study. This adds transparency and helps readers understand the

scope of your research.

- **Future Research** (*if applicable, about 500 characters with spaces*): Suggest possible directions for future research based on your findings.
- **Keywords:** *three to five keywords*
- **JEL Codes:** *in line with [American Economic Association: JEL Codes](#)*

Extended abstracts should be:

- 1.5 line spaced throughout the whole text
- Times New Roman 12-point font (except for the title, which should be in Times New Roman 14-point font)
- A4 size page formatting
- 2.5 cm margins on all sides
